Commencement of Even Semester (Academic Session 2020-21)

1. Reference AKTU letter No. ए०के०टी०यू० / प०नि०का० / 2021 / 4503 dated 24 February 2021.
2. Classes for the even semester (academic session 2020-21) will commence in off line mode as under –
 - (a) BBA and BCA (Second and Third Year) – 15 March 2021
 - (b) Rest of the courses – 05 April 2021
(B. Tech./MBA/MCA - First to final Year)
(BBA/BCA - First Year)
3. Attention of all concerned is drawn on following points –
 - (a) Safety Precautions against COVID 19. All concerned will ensure compliance of Government directions on safety precautions against COVID-19 i.e. wearing of mask, social distancing, and frequent washing of hands etc. The wash rooms are being provided with soap and the masks can be purchased, if needed, from the cafeteria at a price of Rs. 10/- per piece.
 - (b) Hostel Facility. Students, desirous of joining hostel, should pay hostel fee of one semester i.e. Rs. 37,500/- plus caution money (Rs. 5000/-) if applicable.
 - (c) Bus Facility. Students desirous of availing bus facility should pay bus fee for one semester i.e. Rs. 11000/- and get the bus pass made from the Admin Office before commencement of semester. Entry in buses will be strictly on Bus Pass.
 - (d) Payment of balance of Annual Fee. The last installment of annual fees is payable in the first 15 days of college opening for BBA/BCA students and within a week for the rest. Students should clear their dues accordingly to avoid payment of late fee. Notices on the subject dated 14 August 2020 and dated 20 November 2020 refer.
4. Only for the students admitted in session 2020-21.
 - (a) I-Card. They must collect their I-Card from Registrar's Office on any working day. Entry in classroom is strictly prohibited without I-Card.

- (b) Library Books. They may draw books or set of books under the Book Bank scheme before the start of session.
 - (c) College Uniform. The newly admitted students must collect their uniform/ kit bag from the Accounts Office and get the uniform stitched at the earliest. Wearing of uniform is compulsory for attending the classes.
 - (d) Induction Programme. The instructions on induction programme will be issued separately.
5. All concerned, especially the senior students must note that Ragging in any form is a punishable offence, and is therefore strictly prohibited.
