#### 1, General:

India is a country of diversity. It is a hub of different religions, castes and cultures. However, the Indian society is characterized by an entrenched system of social stratification. Social inequalities have led to denial of access to materials, cultural and educational resources to the disadvantaged groups of societies. Higher education is a tool for social and economic equality; therefore, the SRMGPC has constituted SC/ST Committee as per AICTE norms.

### Objectives:

According to AICTE norms, the SC/ST committee (As per the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989, No 33 of 1989, dated 11 November 1989) has the following objectives:

- To implement the reservation policy for SCs/STs in the Institution; collect data regarding the implementation of the policies in respect of admissions, appointments to teaching and non-teaching positions in the Institution, and analysis of the data towards fulfilling the required quota.
- Promotes the special interest of students in the reserved category and to provide b. special inputs in areas where the students experience difficulty.
- Conduct remedial coaching classes on life skills, personality development, writing assignments and making presentations and also have to organize interactive sessions and informal meetings with students to attend to their personal, social and academic problems.
